THIS TRUST DEED is made the twenty third day of September One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy Seven by NEIL BUCHANNAN of The Old Grammar School Church Street Uckfield Sussex Solicitor TERENCE BAKER of New Olives High Street Uckfield Sussex Chartered Accountant and ALAN RAVEN EDWARDS of Atheralls Farm Fletching Sussex Farmer (hereinafter called "the Trustees" which expression shall include the survivors or survivor of them or other the Trustees or Trustees for the time being of this deed)

WHEREAS:

(1) The Trustees have collected certain sums of money and gifts for the establishment and maintenance of the Band hereinafter mentioned and now stand possessed of musical instruments music and other items of equipment required for the pursuance of the activities of a Band
(2) The name of the Band so established and maintained is The Uckfield Band

(3) The Trustees are desirous of declaring the trusts relating to the said musical instruments music and other items of equipment in manner hereinafter appearing –

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows :-

1. THE Trustees shall stand possessed of the said instruments music and other equipment and any other equipment or sums of money which may hereafter be received by them (all of which are hereinafter referred to as "the Trust Fund") for the general purposes of The Uckfield Band upon trust to apply the same in establishing and maintaining in accordance with this deed and with and subject to the powers and provisions hereinafter contained a Band for the performance of Band Music for the education of the public in the appreciation of the art of music and in particular band music by the presentation of and appearance at concerts and other venues together with a Junior Band for the teaching and training of young people in instrument playing and musical theory and shall hold the Trust Fund as aforesaid for the general purposes of The Uckfield Band upon trust for the purposes of and as part of the said Band and (subject and without prejudice to the powers and provisions herein contained to permit the same to be used accordingly
2. THE management and control of the Trust Fund and the general policy for its use shall be vested in a Committee of Management (hereinafter called "the Management Committee") duly elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Band
3. THE first elected members of the Management Committee shall be the existing members of the Management Committee of The Uckfield Band elected at the last Annual General Meeting of the Band and thereafter shall consist of the following elected and ex-officio officers namely the President of the Band and the Trustees the Vice Presidents of the Band and the Treasurer



Business Manager and Chairman of the Band Committee. A meeting of the Management Committee shall be convened at the request of any two or more of its members and the quorum for meetings of the Management Committee shall be five

4. THE Annual General Meeting is to be convened by the Band Committee in the month of October or November in each year for the purpose of electing the Officers of the Band and Officers and members of the Management Committee and Band Committee and for taking such action as it may decide and shall be convened by a Notice signed by or on behalf of the Trustees exhibited on the Notice Board of the Uckfield Parish Council for at least fourteen days prior to the date of the Meeting. The quorum for such Annual General Meetings shall be five.
5. The Band Committee shall be responsible for the organisation of the activities of The Uckfield Band and shall consist of the Officers of the Band and not less than three playing members of the band. The Officers of the Band shall be the Musical Advisor Business Manager Secretary Treasurer and Librarian. The Conductor and Trustees for the time being of this deed shall be ex-officio members of the Band Committee
6. ALL members of the Management Committee and the Band Committee (excluding ex-officio members) shall retire annually at the Annual General Meeting but shall be eligible for re-election. Either Committee shall have power to fill any casual vacancy which may occur among its elected members and any person so elected shall hold office until the next Annual General Meeting
7. THE Band Committee may from time to time delegate any of their power to sub-committees consisting of such member or members of their body as they may think fit and they may sanction the co-option of suitable persons on to such sub-committees
8. THE Band Committee may from time to time make and alter rules and Regulations for the conduct of its business and for the summoning and conduct of its Meetings
9. THE power of appointing a new Trustee or new Trustees of this deed shall be vested in the Band Committee but such appointment shall be confirmed at the next Annual General Meeting
10. IF it appears to the Trustees for the time being of this deed that the Uckfield Band has disbanded or the membership of the Band has been reduced to less than six members or if the Band Committee shall fail to meet for a period of six months or if the Band Committee shall so decide then the powers of the Band Committee shall be suspended and the Trust Fund shall become the sole responsibility of the Trustees. The Trustees shall hold and maintain the Trust Fund for the period not less than seven years from the date of the suspension of the powers of the Band Committee and if during that time there shall be no demand made to them by not less, than ten persons willing and able to re-establish The Uckfield Band then thereafter they may in their absolute discretion and after due notice sell and dispose of the Trust Fund in such a manner and for such consideration as they shall think best to the intent that such monies raised thereby or such parts of the Trust Fund as shall not be sold shall be applied to and for the benefit of any other similar charitable purpose determined by the Trustees in accordance with a Scheme to be settled by the Trustees or on application thereto by the Charity Commissioners for England and Wales



11. ALL members of The Uckfield Band shall signify their consent to the terms of the Trust Deed by signing their names in a book to be kept for that purpose
